

Details

- •Food and refreshments will be available on site. 500'x 70'Petromat runway with adjacent grass runway.
- •Grass pit area. Designated area for engine testing. Gas station, convenience store, motels and shopping are just minutes away. There are city and county parks in the area with campgrounds, fishing, hiking, swimming and bike trails to keep the family entertained.
- •All applicable AMA, FCC and Skyhawks regulations governing the pilot, his aircraft, and equipment will be enforced. Pilots must show a valid AMA card when they check in at the flying site.
- •Consideration for the safety of spectators, flight line personnel, and other flyers is of the utmost importance.
- Each pilot will be required to have a spotter with them at all times while on the flight line.
- •All transmitters and receivers must meet narrow-band standards.
- •Maximum aircraft weight with fuel: 55 lbs. unless appropriate LMA documentation is provided at registration.

Take County Home Road to C Avenue Ext (**yellow** blinking light) and turn South. Continue 1/4 mile south to entrance at 3125 C Avenue Ext, Marion Ia. 52302 (42.089, -91.646)
