Todd has badges available for 2019, it's a good time to renew your membership. The Skyhawks membership is by calendar year and not with the cycle of your AMA. You have to renew for 2019 in order to fly at the field.

Officer nominations for 2019 were closed in the last meeting. Rich Dean made the motion to elect officers that were nominated. Mike Tope seconded the motion. Officer voting is closed for 2019. Current officers from 2018 will remain for 2019.

It was mentioned last meeting to have more events. Todd recommended a build and fly competition. More information to come on this. If others have events they would like to see please bring them forward to a monthly meeting. But be prepared to help organize it.

Mike Tope suggested that when we do the runway that we look at having runway access for the planes from the stations. The goal is to get one more year off of the existing mat. There most likely will be a runway committee set up in 2019 to look into replacement. Don Harker suggested that the runway be shifted south to help with the erosion on the north end.

We need to work on the North end of the runway and will look at a committee to investigate possible solutions, Gene T. volunteered to help with that as he has a lot of experience with landscaping. We all agreed that we need to do something to smooth out the north end and will keep it on the agenda.

New Business

No new business was discussed at the meeting.

George Cobley from Civil Air Patrol gave an overview of the organization and the upcoming work they are doing. It was interesting what to hear what the organization was all about. George was just at our meeting trying to learn more about what we do. He has taken on a new role with directing drone pilots working within the Civil Air Patrol.
