Todd feels the runway should be good enough for another year. No further discussion was made on the runway. Jim thought it would be a good idea to start researching the runway and the runway material. Todd thought that could be put off until we decide to replace the runway. A decision was made to leave the matt and get another year out of it.

The Port o Potty has been removed from the field.

New Business

Officer nominations were discussed. Randy would like to step down from secretary's position. Motion to keep existing officers with Randy stepping down was passed. Bob Vertz is willing to step up to the secretary position. Chuck motioned for Bob to run for secretary's position and the motion was passed.

The general consensus was the simpler we can keep the field the better. It would be a major expense to run power to the field. It was tabled. A solar panel/batter option was also discussed. 
