Skyhawks Meeting Minutes

August 29, 2020

Todd Davis opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. at the airfield with 12 members present.

Geoff Barrance gave the treasurer's report. There are currently 73 members paid up for the 2020 season.

- Club has a checking balance of \$17,667.22.
- Treasurer collected 3 membership fees yet to deposit.
- Disbursements were made to pay for the Port-O-Potty and trophy material for the Warbirds event.
- The club has a savings balance of \$2008.68.

David Logan read the minutes from the July 12, 2020 meeting.

Old Business

- Gary Owen talked to the Parks & Recreation department about filling the pot holes. They came out and did it for us. Thank you to the Park & Recreation department for their partnership with us.
- The pattern contest is scheduled for August 22-23. There will be no open flying during that weekend. Mark Barnett mentioned that he has had several inquiries regarding the event. We will have a computerized scoring system available to us that is coming from Kansas City.
- Mark Barnett asked if we should have a 2nd Port-O-Potty available for the contest. The decision was made to wait until we have more information on turn out. We can get one quickly if we need it. Mark will let Geoff Barrance know a head count a week prior to the event.
- Warbird event – Date is set for August 29. We are not promoting the event to the public, but are promoting it to pilots. We should plan on coming out the night before. We will put up the canopy prior to the pattern contest and leave it up for the following weekend warbird event. Hy-Vee will be coming for the Warbirds over Iowa event. Todd Davis is asking for volunteers to help with the event. We will not be doing T-shirts this year since we couldn't sell enough to break even, since no spectators will be encouraged to come.
- Todd Davis and Randy Lepsch made trophies for the Warbirds over Iowa event.

New Business

- A Dynam PT was donated to the club. Todd Davis will take it home with him and plans to sell it on behalf of the club at the upcoming swap meet.
- The swap meet is tentatively scheduled for Saturday, September 19, 2020 with a rain date set for Sunday, September 20, 2020.
- Next scheduled Skyhawks club meeting will be Sunday, September 13 due to the Labor Day weekend falling on the first Sunday of September.
