Iowa City Swap Meet was held on February 1. There appeared to be a lower attendance than previous years. There were more sellers than buyers it seems. No auction this year either. It was stated there was a nice memorial table for Jon McVay.

FAA activities were discussed. It's looking like the aircraft remote ID requirement will not be mandated at designated RC airfields – at least not yet anyway. There have been over 10,000 comments submitted on the FAA website so far. Every one of them counts – it's important that people send in their comments.

#### **Show N Tell**

Don Harker brought a scratch built Dornier DO-217 electric twin. It has a 72" wingspan and made from Menards' 2" pink foam board. Power is a 3S 2200 – 3300 LiPo battery. The airplane is glassed with ½ oz cloth which also serves as the load bearing structure since there isn't a main spar in the wing!

Gene Thorn showed off a scratch built cowl that is going on his Air Hawk. Spare / replacement parts are no longer available for this vintage airplane. It's made out of wooden pieces and looks great. As the saying goes "necessity is the mother of invention"; he also brought a home made glue gun that was used to assemble the cowl. It's actually a turkey marinade injector syringe with Titebond glue inside. Guess it won't be used in the kitchen anymore! He also brought a home made wing bag with custom decal for his Buzzard Bombshell airplane. I didn't even know that Gene could sew!

Dave Logan brought his Best Pilots' hand painted 1/5 scale pilot figure. Dave painted it himself in WWII Pacific Theater USAAF colors. The pilot is Col. Neel Kearby and will be flying in Dave's giant scale P-47B Thunderbolt. Lyle Vasser would be proud!

Todd Davis brought his Best Pilots' hand painted 1/4 scale pilot figure. Todd painted it himself and hand carved the lower body half out of foam. It is super light weight! The pilot is Saburo Sakai and will be flying in Todd's giant scale Ki-61 "Tony". Lyle Vasser would be proud (again)!


Meeting ended at 8:00 PM.




