

Skyhawks Meeting Minutes

August 1, 2021

Meeting was held at the Skyhawks field and was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Todd Davis.

Geoff Barrance gave the Treasurer's Report.

The Secretary's Report was read by Todd Davis in Dave Logan's Absence.

Old Business

Runway Replacement

More discussion was held about the runway replacement. Todd provided details on the current status of talks with contractor Koelker Excavating. We are still trying to see if they have an opening for the work to be done this fall. Wendell is also checking with another contractor that has helped us when we did the original runway work. We hope to get it handled and start the runway work this October.

We plan to be ready to take a vote at the September meeting. Along with the vote to do the work, we need to decide if we should lay the mat down right away after the grading is completed, or wait until spring. Some issues with each choice include:

Lay mat down in the Fall

Less risk of bad spring weather delaying the mat placement
No extra cost that could be incurred from doing additional leveling in the spring
Flying would be available through the winter months
We could run the roller on the new mat in the spring if needed.
Prevents needing to find a place to store the mat over the winter.

Lay mat down next Spring

Allows additional time for runway to settle, preventing the possible need of pulling the mat back up if the tile work settles over the winter.

Members may be more motivated to volunteer to lay down the mat in the spring.

Discussion ensued about the relative merits of each plan. We plan to determine how much more it may cost to lay the mat down in the spring, as well as the contractors thoughts on the likelihood that the ground might settle over the winter. It is expected that a discussion and vote will happen during the September meeting. It was mentioned that we should provide a reminder to all members so everyone who has an opinion can make it to the meeting and vote on this important topic. Todd said he would send out a reminder prior to the next meeting if a vote will take place.

Wendell gave an update on the mat. The vendor has it and has agreed to hold on to it until we need it this fall.

Warbirds Over Iowa News

KCRG "Show you Care" will provide TV ads for the event.

We will need volunteers for various duties, such as the sign up table, flight line direction, spotters, parking, Friday set-up, announcer, etc. Expect an email to come out looking for people to help. General helpers are also needed. There will be a new Warbirds over Iowa shirt that will be given out to each member that helps to be worn during the event. Members are encouraged to fly in the event, and can also help out.

Porta Potty. Discussion ensued on if we should get an extra porta potty to handle the heavy spectator traffic during the event. The Iowa Pattern Contest is the weekend before. Since we basically pay for a full month to get an extra unit, it seems wise to get it ahead of time so we have it for the pattern contest as well.

Todd Davis motioned to get an extra porta potty, Geoff Barrance seconded. Vote was taken and it was unanimous. We will get an extra unit brought out in time to handle both events.
