## **Skyhawks Meeting Minutes**

July 9, 2023

The meeting was held at the field. Todd Davis called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with 15 members present.

Jim Doty gave the Treasurer's Report. We currently have 64 members paid.

David Logan read the Secretary's Report from the June 4<sup>th</sup> meeting.

#### **Old Business**

#### • Theme Day

Our first monthly theme day is coming up on July 22<sup>nd</sup>. Gene Thorn brought some flyers regarding the theme for the day. It will be "Your Oldest Plane." Bring the oldest plane you have. We will have lunch provided for all who bring a theme plane. Anyone is welcome to come and fly but those who do not bring a theme plane will need to pay \$5 if they intend to eat. Todd Davis said we will need to get an email out to get an RSVP from club members, so we know how much food to buy. Everyone should bring a side dish or dessert to share. Todd asked for a volunteer to lead the August theme event. Steve Wilson volunteered and said the theme for August will be "Biplanes." A date has not been set yet.

#### • Airfield Condition

There are a lot of weeds and gopher holes along the runway. We will be planning a field maintenance day soon. We have some events that are sanctioned events in one month and need to have the field in good shape for the events.

Randy Davis volunteered to store the generator and Todd said he would contact some club members who might be able to bring the club trainer up to date and get it flying well. As an interesting note, Jim added that this particular trainer was the first plane to ever takeoff from our old mat that was replaced last year.
