June 4, 2023

The meeting was held at the field. Todd Davis called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. with 11 members present.

Jim Doty gave the Treasurer's Report.

Secretary's Report from the May meeting was read by David Logan.

Old Business

Demo Day

The annual Demonstration Day was held on June 3. Only a few spectators came out. The weather was not ideal. Todd suggested we move the next Demo Day to a later date when weather is more favorable. He also suggested that someone take on this event as a project, so that it can be well planned and promoted, maybe even have a committee formed to work on it.

• Airfield Condition

We will be planning a field maintenance day soon. We have some events that are sanctioned events in one month and need to have the field in good shape for the events.

• Weather Station

The weather station availability came up again this month as a topic for discussion. Todd said if there is one over at the soccer park, it should be owned by the city and we shouldn't need to support it. We should be able to access it at no charge. To access nearby weather stations, download the WeatherLink app from Davis Instruments, then search for a station in the Cedar Rapids area. Corteva station is closest to our field. Todd also suggested just using weather.com and entering Robins, IA for the location. It will give hourly weather forecast with wind predictions for speed and direction.

• Silver Leader Club Status

David Logan informed the club that the Silver Leader Club status with the AMA has been renewed for 2023.

New Business

• Club Theme Fly & Cookout

Gene Thorn brought a detailed proposal for having Club Theme Fly & Cookout events monthly at the field. He suggested themes such as biplanes, WWI, WWII, high wing, jets, etc. be the themes. He proposed making theme days on the third weekend of each month on a Saturday or Sunday depending on the weather. There would be reserved times for the theme planes to fly but would not be exclusive to the themed aircraft. A viewing area would also be set up for the themed aircraft. Lunch or dinner would be provided as part of the event. A theme leader would direct each event and plan for the details regarding food and theme as well as the reserved times.

Some discussion occurred and a vote was taken to see if the club would want to offer thesed events. The events were approved for July and August of this year. Guests from area clubs would be welcome to join as guests. The same rules apply for inviting guest pilots that apply for general club usage. Contact one of the club officers to get permission for the guest to join us. Gene Thorn will coordinate the first event. A leader will be needed to volunteer for the August event. The Electri-fly event will be held July 8 this year and is an AMA sanctioned event so any AMA member is eligible to participate.
