Skyhawks minutes July meeting. July 7, 2024

Meeting notes taken by Todd Davis

Todd Davis called the meeting to order at 7PM.

Treasurer's Report: Todd Davis provided the treasurer's report. Current membership is 62 paid members and 10 life members. Payment was made to LRS Portables for the porty potty install and first month.

Secretary's Report: Todd Davis read the secretary's report from June. The minutes were accepted without revision.

Old Business:

Todd reported that there is no news on the ADA work expected to be done at the field. Todd plans to contact them to find out what is happening, and try to reduce the chance that they will want to do the work in the middle of the busy flying season.

Todd talked to the grounds keeper about helping move items during the mowing process. They indicated they could do it without a problem. They will continue to use the large mower, but plan to return shortly after with the smaller mower to handle the areas the large mower can't get to.

Todd also plans to follow up on the status of the dead tree near the entrance to the field. It would be good to remove the hazard prior to WOI.

Warbirds over Iowa update: Todd reported that KCRG has accepted our event in their "Show you Care" program. This provides us with TV ads prior to the event that helps attendance. Hy-vee has been contacted and is scheduled to provide catering for the event as usual.

Todd reported that the electric Fly will be held on July 20th as scheduled. We will not be holding it as a sanctioned event this year. Non-members can fly in the event as long as they have a valid AMA membership (full, not park flier). There will be no entry fee this year.

Theme day – A vote was taken and passed to have a Foto, Food, and Fun day on August 3rd. Bring any planes that you would like a good photo of. You can also get a photo that can be used on your badge for next year. Food will be served. Meat and basics will be provided by the club. Everyone can bring something to share (pot luck style). Expect event to go from 10-3 with lunch around noon. We hope all of our best photographers can attend (Rich Dean, Randy Lepsch, and John Cox).

New Business:

Wendell mentioned that some new members sent in an entry fee, but didn't know if they were signed up. We plan on doing a better job of following up with an email for any new entry. The email needs to be copied to Todd so we can get new members added to the mailing list. New badges will be provided at the field, since we want to make sure any new members are aware of our rules, and we have a chance to assess the level they are at to determine if they need assistance.

Wendell also mentioned that we could use more instructors. We also need to remove some of the instructors from our list that are no longer active (Chuck Ficken, Mark Barnett). We talked about having a list that includes people who could help in specific areas. Experts for different transmitter types, flying types, etc. If you are willing to help new members in any capacity, please contact Todd Davis.


Show and Tell. A couple items were brought and shown.
