The model is of the first triplane ever built and was introduced by the Canadians into World War I. These planes were responsible for shooting down 33 Albatrosses in 3 months.

This model weighs 4 pounds, 4 ounces les the battery. The wheels, cowling, dummy radial engine, aand machine guns were all 3D printed by his son, Bradford. He is using a 4-cell 4000 mAh battery for power with a 720 KV motor. The decals on it are made from Avery labels. Good job, Gene. We look forward to the maiden flight.
